OPEN SPACE AND TRAILS AD HOC COMMITTEE MEETING  
MEETING MINUTES  
JANUARY 6, 2010, 3:00 P.M.**

**A REGULAR MEETING OF THE DEWEY-HUMBOLDT OSAT COMMITTEE MEETING WAS HELD ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2010, AT TOWN HALL AT 2735 S. HIGHWAY 69, DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA.**

**1. CALL TO ORDER.** The Open Space and Trails Committee meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. Community Development Director, Dennis Price, presided until the appointment of officers.

**2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.** Made.

**3. ROLL CALL:** Carol Barker, Skip Gladue, Sandra Goodwin, Jack Hamilton, Judy Kerber, Kevin Leonard, Norman Perry, and Heidi Remakel were present. Darrell Hudson withdrew from the Committee prior to the meeting.

**6. REGULAR AGENDA - New Business**

**6.1. Formation and initial briefing of Open Space and Trails Committee.**  
An overview of the Committee's role. Open Meeting Law overview was given by Town Clerk, Judy Morgan. Dennis Price discussed the Committee's Mission and Duties.

**6.2. Appointment of a Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary.**  
Jack Hamilton nominated Norman Perry for Chair. Norman Perry declined. Sandra Goodwin nominated Jack Hamilton; Norman Perry seconded the nomination; the vote was unanimous. The following members were nominated for Vice Chair but declined: Sandra Goodwin, Norm Perry, Heidi Remakel, and Kevin Leonard. Carol Barker was nominated and accepted the office of Vice Chair. Sandra Goodwin suggested the Town fill the role of Secretary, Jack Hamilton concurred. Appointment of officers was made. Jack Hamilton, Chair, Carol Barker, Vice Chair, and Town Staff will serve in the role of Secretary.

**6.3. Initial Project Discussion.** In light of the 2009 General Plan and the 2009-2010 Capital Improvement Plan, where do we go from here?

Jack Hamilton presided on this item forward. Discussed confines of previous committees and asked for more options with this committee. There was

discussion regarding the schedule for the meetings. Chair Hamilton would like a meeting on January 20th to discuss proposals made by ADYE, but will make that decision after the January 13th meeting. He spoke on the Dewey-Humboldt Town Vision 2028 and also the trails in the 2009 General Plan. Sandra Goodwin spoke on the CIP Committee getting a lot of public input on the trails. There was discussion on trails and the General Plan showing trails on private property. There was a request from Carol Barker for maps of the trails. Sandra Goodwin spoke on some options for trails deviating from private property onto public access ways.

**6.4. Schedule Discussion.** Next meeting will be with consultant from ADYE on January 13, 2010. Chair Hamilton tentatively scheduled another meeting for January 20 and will confirm that meeting after the January 13 meeting with ADYE. Committee members were asked what they want to see out of this committee. Items included: the importance of proper entrances, exits and trail ways through the town; separate trails for ATVs from pedestrians and equestrians; new roads allowing access for safer trails for pedestrian travel; teaching the public about trail etiquette and rights. Chair Hamilton spoke on BLM Land and rules for usage.

**7. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC.** Chair Hamilton invited comments from the Public at 3:50 p.m.

Tammy DeWitt, Planner for Yavapai County, spoke on the regional trail plan.

David Nystrom spoke on the Committee's role.

Joel Berman, Public Works Project Manager, discussed provision of maps for the Committee.

George Sheets spoke on his experience and offered to be a resource for the Committee.

Tina Knoy spoke on trails through private property.

**8. ADJOURN.** The meeting was adjourned at 4:08 p.m.
