

**ORDINANCE Nº 10-77**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, AMENDING TOWN CODE §§ 30.105 AND 30.104; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ANY ORDINANCE OR PART OF ORDINANCES OR CODE PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.**

**Whereas**, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt believes that amendment and clarification of Town Code § 30.105 will confirm to the community that Town Council carefully controls the Council's agenda;

**Now, Therefore**, be it ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona as follows:

1. Amendment of Dewey-Humboldt Town Code § 30.105. Town Code § 30.105 is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety by the following:

**§ 30.105 COUNCIL AGENDA.**

- (A) On behalf of the Council, the Mayor, Vice Mayor, and one Councilmember (on a monthly rotating basis) will meet, in consultation with the Town Manager, to discern and plan which items are ready or need to be placed on the agenda and the timing for scheduling those items. The Manager will then prepare a memorandum for distribution to the Council containing all agenda items currently scheduled. The Mayor or Vice-Mayor should be contacted if an individual Councilmember wishes to modify that schedule.
- (B) Any resident of Dewey-Humboldt or staff member may request placement of a matter on the Council agenda by requesting that a Councilmember submit a "Council Agenda Action Form."
- (C) Any member of the Town Council may suggest an agenda item for the next regular council meeting and the item shall be placed on the agenda.
- (D) In order to accurately describe what agenda action is proposed, the "Council Agenda Action Form" should be used and submitted at least six days prior to the next regularly schedule council meeting.
- (E) Any new item will be placed under "New Business" for the council to determine its disposition. It can be acted upon at that meeting, sent to staff for more work, sent to the appropriate board or commission, set for a work session, tabled to a future date, or dropped.

2. Amendment of Dewey-Humboldt Town Code § 30.104. Town Code § 30.104 is hereby amended by appending the following to the end thereof:

The Mayor or three Councilmembers may call for a special meeting or special work session as he or she deems appropriate to conduct town business subject to the requirements of the Open Meetings Law and posting of meeting notices.

3. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be effective at the soonest date after its passage and approval, according to law.

4. Savings Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance as amended is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.


5. Repeal. All other code provisions, ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date hereof. However, nothing in this Ordinance is intended or will be effective to change or otherwise affect exemptions from fees otherwise contained in Town Code: such exemptions shall continue in full force and effect.


