

ORDINANCE N^o 11-89

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, CHAPTER 30 TOWN COUNCIL AND OFFICIALS, BY AMENDING SECTION 30.105 COUNCIL AGENDA, BY AMENDING SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (C) RELATED TO AGENDAS FOR MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1 In General.

The Code of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona is hereby amended by amending Chapter 30 Town Council and Officials, by amending Section 30.105 Council Agenda, Subsections (A) and (C) as follows (deleted text appears in ~~strikeout~~; new text in ALL CAPS):

30.105 COUNCIL AGENDA.

(A) ~~On behalf of the Council, the Mayor, Vice Mayor and one Councilmember (on a monthly rotating basis) will meet, in consultation with the Town Manager, to discern and plan which items are ready or need to be placed on the agenda and the timing for scheduling those items.~~ THE MANAGER AND CLERK ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR RECEIVING AND ORGANIZING ALL MATERIALS FOR THE AGENDA, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MAYOR AND VICE-MAYOR. The Manager will then prepare a memorandum for distribution to the Council containing all agenda items currently scheduled. The Mayor or Vice Mayor should be contacted if an individual Councilmember wishes to modify that schedule.

(C) Any member of the Town Council may suggest an agenda item for the next regular Council meeting and the item shall be placed on the agenda. IF A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL HAS REQUESTED THE MODIFICATION OR REMOVAL OF AN AGENDA ITEM THAT WAS PLACED ON THE AGENDA BY ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE TOWN COUNCIL, SUCH MODIFICATION OR REMOVAL SHALL REQUIRE THE CONCURRENCE OF THAT MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL.


Section II. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed.


Section III Savings Clause.
