A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, DEFINING THE PROTOCOL TO BE FOLLOWED AT REGUAR COUNCIL MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the Council desires to clarify the process for conducting regularly Scheduled Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to encourage public comment and input on items and issues being considered by the Council:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt hereby defines the following protocol for the purpose of conducting business at its regularly scheduled meetings:

Staff presentation of the item – report, outline of the issue, summary of the requested action, etc.

Questions of Staff by the Council,

Request for comments from the public (Comments will not be requested regarding items that concern issues or actions that have been scheduled for an Executive Session as provided by State law – i.e. employee review, salary discussions, lease or real estate purchases etc.),

Possible additional discussion by the Council or presentation of information by staff appropriate to comments made by the public,

Additional questions of Staff by the Council, identification of possible modifications to the item,

Request for a motion by the Mayor,

Motion and second,


Council discussion,

Call the question.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall be effective March 22nd, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt will include these provisions in its Town Code to be adopted by Ordinance at a future date.


