

**RESOLUTION N<sup>o</sup> 09-66**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT TO REQUEST FROM CENTRAL YAVAPAI METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO BECOME A PARTICIPATING MEMBER.**

**Whereas**, the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization was established and designated by the Governor of the State of Arizona to conduct a continuing, coordinated, and comprehensive (3C) transportation planning process, working in collaboration with Federal, State and Local Planning Partners; and

**Whereas**, the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization is funded through transportation funds secured through the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, available grants and other outside sources, and contributions from Participating Agencies; and

**Whereas**, an Intergovernmental Agreement was executed May of 2003, between Yavapai County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona; the City of Prescott, a municipal corporation of Arizona; the Town of Prescott Valley, a municipal corporation of Arizona; and the Town of Chino Valley, a municipal corporation of Arizona to become Participating Local Agencies of the Transportation Planning Organization; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt is interested in joining Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization as a Participating Agency; and


**Whereas**, the Town of Dewey Humboldt is interested in being part of such a regional transportation planning process and activities; and

**Whereas**, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt municipal limits are within the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization planning area boundary;

**Now, Therefore**, Be it resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona, that:


