

RESOLUTION N^o 09-70

A RESOLUTION FORMALIZING THE PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT AND CENSUS 2010 THROUGH THE FORMATION OF A COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE.

Whereas, the next Decennial Census will be taken in the Year 2010; and political representation to the United States House of Representatives, state legislatures, and local government is determined by the Decennial Census, and the Town of Dewey-Humboldt recognizes the equal importance of each resident in the 2010 Census Count; and

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt has agreed to be one of 40,000 governmental entities in partnership with the United States Bureau of the Census; and

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt understands that its primary role in this partnership is to formulate a Complete Count Committee; and

Whereas, the role of the committee is to create census awareness; bridge the gap between the community and the Census Bureau on geographic matters, outreach activities, and information centers; to inform, motivate and educate the Town's residents in the necessity and importance of their rapid response and 100% participation in Census 2010.




