

RESOLUTION N^o 10-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, CONTINUING THE FY2010 BUDGET UNTIL ADOPTION OF THE DEWEY-HUMBOLDT FY2011 BUDGET; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt has an important responsibility to its citizens to carefully account for public funds, to manage its finances wisely, and to plan for the adequate funding of services desired by the public, including the provision and maintenance of public facilities;

Whereas, the Town FY2011 Budget (the "Budget") has been developed by the Town to deliver quality services in an affordable, efficient, and cost-effective basis providing full value for each tax dollar; to maintain an adequate financial base to sustain a sufficient level of municipal services, thereby preserving the quality of life in the Town of Dewey-Humboldt; and to have the ability to withstand local and regional economic fluctuations, to adjust to changes in the service requirements of our community, and to respond to changes in Federal and State priorities and funding as they affect the Town's residents;

Whereas, the Budget has been carefully reviewed by Council, who believes that it does not yet fairly provide for the provision of public goods and services furthering the health, safety, and welfare of the Town's citizens;


Whereas, the Council needs further time to deliberate on the FY2011 Budget; and

Whereas, the Town must continue to function and provide the public goods and services required of it by law.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona:

1. Continuing Effect. The activities and expenses outlined in the Dewey-Humboldt FY2010 Budget shall continue to be pursued and funds expended in FY2011 at the same pace and value as in FY2010 until such time as the Council adopts a final budget for FY2011.
2. Emergency. In that the date of the start of the fiscal year is sooner than 30 days after the date of this resolution, and the health, safety, and welfare of the citizenry will be severely impacted by the cessation of Town activity, the Council hereby declares an emergency.
3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective as of the 1st day of July 2010.


