

**RESOLUTION N<sup>o</sup> 11-94**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, STATING ITS PREFERENCE FOR YAVAPAI COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICT MAP A, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE, YAVAPAI COUNTY SUPERVISORY DISTRICT MAP B; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.**

**Whereas**, after each census, counties are required by federal law to re-draw supervisorial district boundaries to equalize district populations; and

**Whereas**, Arizona Revised Statutes state that when a county has reached a population exceeding 175,000 persons, it shall expand to a 5 member board; and


**Whereas**, the Census 2010 listed Yavapai County's population at 211,033; and

**Whereas**, the town Council and Staff have analyzed four proposed maps as released by Yavapai County to determine their impact upon the Town and its residents.

**Now, Therefore**, Be It resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona, as follows:


1. That the Town of Dewey-Humboldt states its preference for Map A.
2. In the alternative, if Map A is not favored by a majority of County Supervisors, Map B is also acceptable.


