

**Agenda Item # 3.1 Old Black Canon Highway Maintenance issue and Council direction for future maintenance.**

**To: Town Council**

**Recommendations:**

**Option 1 – direct staff to conduct proper maintenance beginning FY 14-15 (see attached cost estimate)**

**Option 2 – clearly direct staff to treat this roadway as a private roadway which means the town would refrain from any maintenance, including mowing and pot-holing (as potholing is no longer effective).**

**Summary:**

Although Old Black Canyon Hwy was maintained and paved by the County (before D-H incorporation) and has been used by the public at 500 cars a day (2011 data), it belongs to numerous owners including but not limited to the Town of Dewey-Humboldt. Due to the lack of legal description of the overlapping pieces of the road, the Town is not certain which parts the Town holds title for.

Due to the complication and perhaps other issues that staff is not aware of, the road's proper maintenance has been put on hold for quite a few years, since at least 2010. The town has been limiting the maintenance to "pot holing" and occasionally mowing, only. The practice is temporary and is not how the town maintains other town-owned paved roads.

During the past discussions about the roadway, Council seemed to uphold a collective position that staff should continue the current maintenance practice for OBCH ("potholing and mowing" only, as opposed to maintain it properly like town-owned paved roads).

While staff has been diligent to carry out your direction on limited and temporary maintenance, the roadway has been deteriorating to a point that potholing is no longer efficient or effective. Recently Public Works staff potholed those areas on OBC Hwy that are of safety concerns, the material cost was about \$500 and the work took 2 employees one day along with the Public Works (PW) Supervisor's constant supervision to complete. PW staff anticipates that the same work needs to be done 6 times a year in order to keep it up. The effort and money spent to pothole OBC Hwy is no longer efficient or effective from an operational stand point. The road has become an operation nuisance for the three-man department, and staff does not recommend to continue it. (For background, Town Public Works Department has only three employees including the Supervisor. They maintain 50 miles of town roads.)

In order to properly preserve the road, staff proposes that drainage needs to be repaired and then the roadway can be repaired and chip-sealed. The job can be conducted through a combination of in-house work and by contractors. The cost estimates in the amount of approximately \$100,000 are included in the packet and the job can be spread out in three or more years.

Legal counsel, in their August 2012 opinion, has recommended that the Town conduct a survey to come up with legal descriptions of all intertwined road pieces; then the town can proceed to acquire the pieces that do not belong to the town. Although this approach would pose minimum risk, I, as the Town Manager, do not believe that the cost and time involved in this solution is practical.

The third option that staff has come up with is to completely refrain from any maintenance on OBC Hwy. Although this option would save the town money, staff does not recommend this due to the complication of the ownership and the frequent use of the road.





**Summary:**

At the August 12<sup>th</sup> meeting, staff presented the draft policy on formal presentations at a council meeting. Council wanted to further revise the policy. Staff also developed a “request form” to accompany the policy. The draft policy and the form were distributed to Council members on August 13<sup>th</sup> so that individual members can make revisions to their liking.

One council member had decided to share her input with staff. At this meeting, staff anticipates individual members will voice input to the Council. Staff can then compile the collective revisions. Eventually, the revised policy will be adopted by the Council at a future meeting.

## TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT

### COUNCIL POLICY ON FORMAL PRESENTATIONS AT COUNCIL MEETINGS

**Purpose:** To set forth the guidelines for placing formal presentations by individuals and private entities on the Council's public meeting agenda.

**Applicability:** This policy applies to all requests by individuals and outside entities to make formal presentations at Council public meetings. It does not apply to individuals who wish to speak at the Comments from the Public item on an agenda.

**Policy:** The Town Council often receives requests from individuals and public and private entities to make presentations at Council meetings. The primary mission of the Council is to set policy to govern in the best interests of the Town and its residents in compliance with Arizona law. To that end, there may be occasions where information provided at a formal presentation would be helpful to the Council in its deliberations and planning for the Town. In addition, there may be occasions where the public is benefited from hearing a formal presentation on topics that may affect the community.


*Requests to Make Formal Presentation.* A written request shall be filed with the Town Manager on a form provided by the Town Manager. The request shall include the name of the individual or entity desiring to make the presentation, the proposed date of the Council meeting, the topic and a short description of the content of the presentation, and any other information required by the Town Manager. The Town Manager shall forward it to the agenda committee and if it conforms to the guidelines set forth in this policy, the agenda committee shall place the presentation on the Council agenda.

*Guidelines for Acceptance of Request.* The Agenda Committee shall use one or more of the following criteria to determine whether a requested presentation will be placed on the Council's agenda:

- The presentation addresses an issue on which the Council has requested information.
- The presentation was requested by four members of the Council.
- The presentation was requested by the Town Manager.
- The presentation provides factual information regarding a ballot question on an upcoming election, but does not support or oppose the ballot question.
- The presentation will not support or oppose a candidate for public office.
- The presentation is not an advertisement for a product or service.

*Procedures for Presentations.* Presentations shall not exceed ten minutes unless the Council votes to extend that time. If any special equipment is requested, the Town Manager shall be notified by the presenter at least 72 hours before the Council meeting.

## Process and Procedures for hearing Ethics Complaints filed in Dewey-Humboldt

1. Complaint Filed with Clerk
2. Complaints must be filed upon discovery...or within 30 calendar days of alleged incident
3. Ethics Committee Chair notified (or in succession order of seniority if named or recused) and documents copied to all committee members for review pre meeting by Clerk
4. Chair calls committee meeting to discuss complaint and determine if it should move forward to a hearing and if so, what if any additional materials, statements or witnesses might need to be called For that hearing. Original docs maintained and secured by Staff
5. Notices sent out as to hearing date and for materials, appearances, statements etc by Town Clerk. Two weeks given for all materials to be aggregated and copied to and reviewed by committee prior to hearing. Exceptions can be made and hearing rescheduled by consensus of hearing panel for unforeseen circumstances. (witness out of town etc) *(Refusal to appear or participate? What remedy) Discussion needed*

### Hearing Process

1. Called to order by Chair
2. Complaint or outline of complaint read into record/and to those present
3. Complainant then respondent make opening statements explaining their positions
4. The complainant and respondent in that order may present their case and evidence
5. Committee can ask questions at any time
6. Committee calls witnesses they have requested and asks questions. Both complainant and respondent may ask questions of these witnesses
7. Chairperson may eliminate any questions they feel argumentative or irrelevant to proceedings. Must be agreed to by consensus of ethics committee. All testimony must be in support of complaint or rebuttal of same
8. After witnesses are excused and all material reviewed and there are no further questions form the hearing panel
9. Both complainant and respondent in that order may make a uninterrupted closing statement (summation of case or rebuttal of same)
10. The chair will then close the comments portion of the hearing and the hearing panel will enter discussion and come to a conclusion.

11. Their conclusion and recommendation will then be sent via the town clerk for inclusion on the next to the Town Council meeting agenda for discussion and legal action. (a vote to approve or amend).




