

RESOLUTION NO. 18-129

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, IN SUPPORT OF NORTHERN ARIZONA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS' FEDERAL FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt is a small, rural northern Arizona community known as Arizona's Country Town, and

WHEREAS, Dewey-Humboldt's citizens consistently express pioneering spirit and cherish their independence and self-sufficiency, and

WHEREAS, the complexities and stresses of the 20th and 21st centuries have compelled communities to join together, sharing resources and solving problems, and

WHEREAS, Dewey-Humboldt is a member of the Northern Arizona Council of Governments which represents four Northern Arizona counties – Apache, Coconino, Navajo, and Yavapai – and all their cities and towns, and


WHEREAS, the Northern Arizona Council of Governments was incorporated in 1975 at the behest of the Federal Government - along with innumerable councils of government across the United States - to comprehensively and more efficiently provide services to vulnerable populations, and

WHEREAS, annually, since incorporation in 1975, the service programs and improvement projects conducted by the Northern Arizona Council of Governments with Federal assistance have saved, stabilized and improved the lives of thousands of Northern Arizona residents, and

WHEREAS, the proposed fiscal year 2018 Federal Budget proposes massive reductions in funding the long-established services and programs for the distressed and vulnerable residents of Northern Arizona.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona, vigorously oppose the proposed Federal funding reduction and strenuously request that the Federal funding supporting the Northern Arizona Council of Governments continues at existing levels.
