## **COVID-19 UPDATE: Monday, January 24, 2022**

**Free Masks:** The White House announced plans to make 400 million N95 masks available to all for FREE.

- Masks will start to be available at pharmacies and community health centers later this week.
- The program is expected to be fully up and running by early February.
- ADHS will share additional information once available.

**Free COVID-19 Vaccines and Boosters:** YCCHS will be on site to provide COVID-19 Moderna 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose vaccines and boosters. Please bring your insurance card. There is no cost for uninsured individuals.

**Prescott Date:** Monday-Friday. **Time:** 8:00-5:30pm. **Location:** Pioneer Park Front Parking Lot, 1200 Commerce Dr, Prescott. PCR test currently, rapid test coming to this location soon. Drive through testing.

**Prescott Valley Date: Please note: no testing on Monday 1/24 and Tuesday 1/25.** Free COVID Testing this week on Wednesday through Friday, and Monday-Friday following weeks. **Time:** 8:00 am-5:30 pm. **Location:** Humboldt Unified School District Office, 6411 N. Robert Road, Prescott Valley. PCR test currently, rapid test coming to this location soon. Walk up testing.

**Cottonwood Date:** Tuesdays and Thursdays (Through Feb. 1, 22). **Time:** 10 am-12pm **Location:** Cottonwood Fire Station, 199 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Rapid test drive through testing will be set up at the entrance of the parking lot off East Aspen Street and exiting onto south 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Yavapai County reports 836 COVID-19 Cases and 5 Deaths since Friday January 21, 2022.** The county has tested 129,343 residents for COVID-19 in the past 6 months, and there have been 42,700 positive cases and 1,039 deaths since the beginning of the pandemic. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports **65** COVID-patients, VVMC reports **27** patients, and the VA reports **4** patients. The County is still experiencing high transmission of COVID-19 with a **30.3%** positivity rate and 959 cases per 100,000 residents for the week ending January 9, 2022. If you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or what seems to be a bad cold, please get tested for COVID-19 and/or Flu. **ADHS COVID-19 Hotline – (844) 542-8201** (select Option number Eight) – help in English and Spanish from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week, except for major holidays.
