USE OF RV AS GUEST HOME

The question has come up many times, about the ability of residents to use a travel trailer, motor home, or recreational vehicle as occasional overflow guest room for relatives or guests.

It is possible to do so, for a period not to exceed 90 days of continuous occupation, and subject to the following:

§ 153.086 OUTSIDE STORAGE

(4) *Temporary use of a travel trailer, motor home or recreational vehicle as an occasional overflow guest room for non-paying or non-reimbursing relatives or guests is authorized as outlined provided such interim use does not exceed 90 days of continuous duration or a total of 90 days in a year or one 12-month period. Temporary use of recreational vehicles shall be only authorized upon satisfaction of the following performance criteria:*

(a) *Subject property is occupied by a permitted primary residential structure.*

(b) *The Yavapai County Environmental Unit shall be furnished with information to determine that the septic or sanitary facilities are adequate to accommodate additional effluent from the temporary recreational vehicle (RV) unit installation.*

(c) *Verification by the Zoning Administrator that the foregoing criteria have been addressed prior to authorizing occupancy of the unit.*

The Zoning Administrator will keep a log of those registering their guests and verifying clearance by Yavapai County.

MARCH 8TH ELECTION RECALL & PROPOSITION 455

The Town has called a Special Election to consider Proposition 455, amending Dewey-Humboldt Town Code 10.99, General Penalty for the Town of Dewey-Humboldt.

The Special Election is being held for the purposes of a recall of Councilmember Barry Thomas.

This will be an All Mail Ballot Election (no polling place will be provided) with Ballots mailed.

You may vote in person through Election Day at the Yavapai County Recorder's Office 1015 Fair Street, Room 228, Prescott. You can also drop off your Ballot at the Humboldt Election Drop Box located outside of Town Hall.

2022 PRIMARY & GENERAL ELECTION

Staff is preparing for the upcoming 2022 Primary and General Election. The election will be for the Mayoral seat and Town Council Member seats.

Candidate packets are available at Town Hall and can also be accessed on the Town website.

Dates to keep in mind:

March 5 - First day for candidates to file nominating paperwork.

April 4 by 5:00 p.m. - Deadline for candidates to file nominating paperwork.

July 5 - Voter Registration Deadline for the Primary Election.

July 6 - Early ballots will be mailed for the Primary Election.

August 2 - Primary Election Day.

October 10 - Voter Registration Deadline for the General Election.

October 12 - Early ballots will be mailed for the General Election.

November 8 - General Election Day.

BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The Town regularly receives questions on whether a building permit is needed for a structure. The easy answer is "Call the Building Official at (928) 632-7362 and find out!"

Oftentimes inquiries on zoning and permitting matters can lead to complicated scenarios, and it is not always easy to give a generalized answer. In the case of building a structure under 400 square feet, the Town's Code of Ordinances, **Section 105.2.1**, provides that: **A building permit shall not be required for the following:**

One-story detached accessory buildings on residential properties used as tool and storage sheds, garages, carports, playhouses, animal shades, barns, and similar uses, provided the area does not exceed 400 square feet under roof and not to exceed a height of 12 feet from natural grade to the mean roof height. **The site of the accessory building must meet all setbacks and requires a zoning clearance permit to verify this.** Detached accessory buildings shall not be considered or used as habitable space. A separate building permit is required for any plumbing, electrical or mechanical systems in all detached buildings.

As one finds out from reading the above code, there are a great deal of variables. Just a couple of examples: commercial structures and residential structures are subject to different rules; if your barn exceeds a certain height, then it would be subject to a different set of rules.
