SPRING CLEAN UP DAYS!



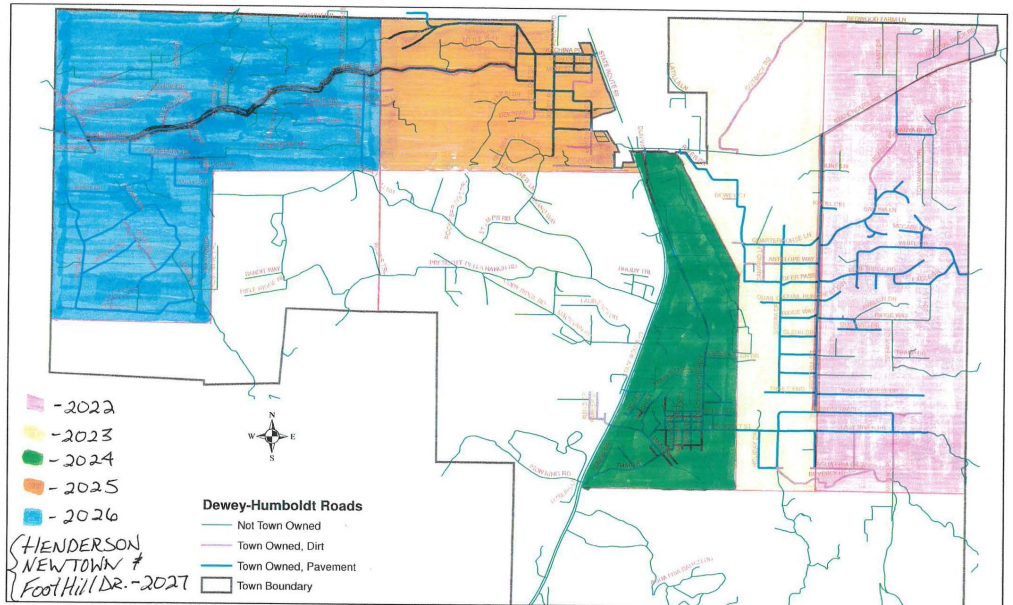
Starting on **Monday, May 23** and continuing through **Thursday, May 26**, the Town will be accepting discarded items. Hours of operation will be from 8:00—5:00 p.m.

There will be two locations, the Town lot at 12938 E. Main St. and the Maintenance Yard at S. Dana and E. Third St.

At the **E. Main St. location**, dumpsters will be available to handle your discards. Yard clippings, pine needles and horehounds **will only** be accepted in trash bags. Items that **will not** be accepted are: tires; oils; hazardous chemicals; refrigerators/freezers with freon/coolant canisters attached; household trash; and batteries.

HOT PATCH REPAIRS

Beginning in April, the Public Works Department will be patching the roads in the Town in preparation for the annual Chipseal Project. The annual Chipseal Project entails a chip overlay of existing roads throughout Town with a fog (a thin liquid oil) coating once the chips are applied.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR CHIP SEAL OVERLAY PROJECT

The Town of Dewey-Humboldt is accepting Requests for Proposals for the Spring 2022 Chip-Seal Overlay Project. Competitive sealed Proposals (with 3 copies) for these services will be received by the Town Clerk's Office until April 14th by 2:00 p.m.

Work includes placing approximately 76,901 square yards of low volume single chip seal and fog coat; 1,867 square yards of low volume double chip seal and fog coat; and 2,904 linear feet of double yellow striping.

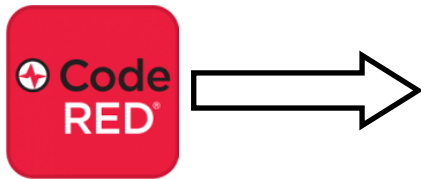

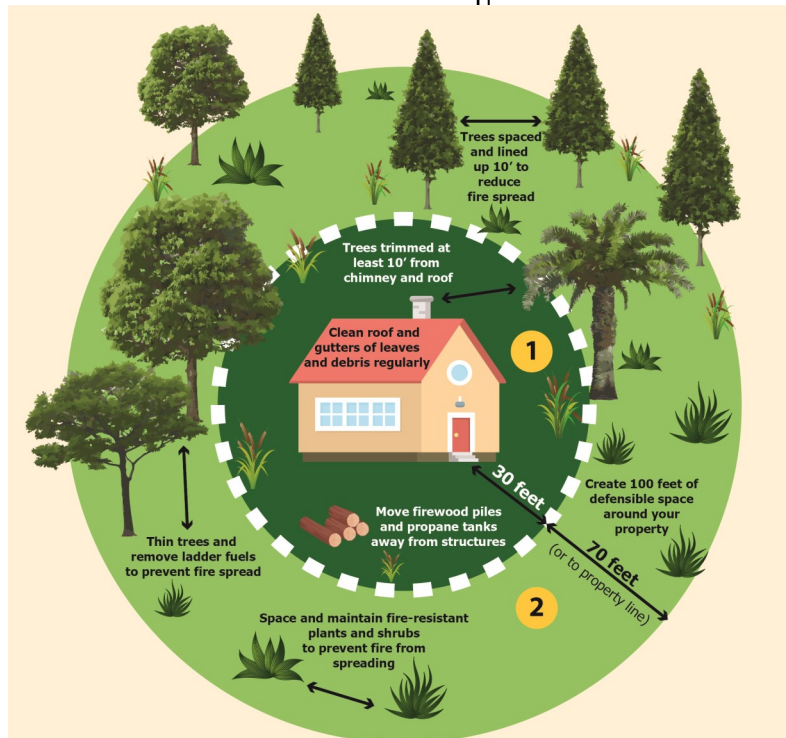

CODE RED EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Yavapai County Sheriff's Office utilizes CodeRED® as its **Emergency Notification System**.

With this service messages can be sent to residents and businesses within minutes containing specific information when an emergency or time-sensitive issue arises.

Although **ENS** does contain published landline phone number information by default, landline phone data may only get updated twice a year. This is why it is **vital that you register all your phone numbers directly to assure contact in an emergency**.

By signing up, you also have the ability to enter alternate phone numbers and/or modes of contact. You may also specify your primary contact mode. The opt-in process will require that you have a valid email address. A confirmation email and/or text message will be sent upon completion of registration. This message will be sent from noreply@ycsoaz.gov and may take up to five minutes. Once registered, you may opt-out at any time. **Sign up at: yscoaz.gov**



MARCH 8TH SPECIAL ELECTION RESULTS

RECALL & PROPOSITION 455

Councilmember Barry Thomas will continue to hold his seat on the Town Council after receiving 51.49% of the ballots cast vs Christopher Baker receiving 47.89% of the ballots cast. Proposition 455 an amendment to Town Code 10.99 General Penalty failed with 60.56% of the ballots cast voting "No".

2022 PRIMARY & GENERAL ELECTION NEWS

The Town's 2022 candidate elections will be for the Mayoral (two-year term of office) seat and three Town Council Member (four-year terms of office) seats.

Candidate packets are available at Town Hall and can also be accessed on the Town website.

Dates to keep in mind:

April 4 by 5:00 p.m. - Deadline for candidates to file nominating paperwork.

May 23 - Campaign signs go up

July 5 - Voter Registration Deadline for the Primary Election.

July 6 - Early ballots will be mailed for the Primary Election.

August 2 - Primary Election Day.

October 10 - Voter Registration Deadline for the General Election.

October 12 - Early ballots will be mailed for the General Election.

November 8 - General Election Day.
