COVID-19 Update: Wednesday April 13, 2022

The past two years have shown us that public health is critical. Public health is more than a single topic; it's countless issues and practices that help every American live healthy, long, and productive lives. There are countless ways to become part of the movement for public health: Celebrate and reinforce gratitude for public health. Look for ways to strengthen our communities, locally and globally. COVID-19 Free Testing Sites: We ask that you wear a mask at our testing sites and that you only come to be tested if you are symptomatic or have been recently exposed to Covid-19.

Prescott and Prescott Valley Days: Yavapai County Community Health Services is pleased to announce the opening of a new Covid-19 testing site on States Route 69 starting April 4th, 2022. The site is located at Prescott Valley Crossroads, 5757 E State Rte. 69, Prescott Valley and will operate Monday -Friday 8:00am-4:00pm, Saturday 9:00am-5:00pm. Testing will be free with no appointment necessary. The site will offer PCR tests with results in 48-72 hours. Our testing location at Pioneer Park is no longer operating.

Cottonwood Days: Monday-Friday. **Time:** 8:00am-5:30pm. **Location:** 300 South Willard St Cottonwood, AZ 86326. PCR test.

Camp Verde Days: Monday-Friday. **Time:** 8:00am-5:30pm. **Location:** 1298 W Finnie Flat Rd Camp Verde, AZ 86322. PCR test.

COVID-19 Free Testing Sites: We ask that you wear a mask at our testing sites and that you only come to be tested if you are symptomatic or have been recently exposed to Covid-19.

Yavapai County reports 80 COVID-19 Cases and 3 Deaths since Wednesday April 6, 2022. There have been positive 47, 935 cases and 1,201 deaths since the beginning of the pandemic. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports **11** COVID-patients, VVMC reports **2** patients, and the VA reports **0** patients.
