NEWS FROM TOWN HALL

EPA & ADEQ UPDATE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is busy responding to public comments received on the proposed plan for cleanup and then making the selection of the final cleanup alternative for the Iron King Mine / Humboldt Smelter Superfund site. In the meantime, we are conducting some additional sampling and other activities that will help us to design the cleanup action, which is the next step in the cleanup process. The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) will be supporting EPA by assisting in these field work activities. ADEQ will have crews in the area assessing land conditions, collecting soil samples, and visually inspecting various areas near the mine and smelter and surrounding properties. Workers may be intermittently on the site or in town until the end of 2023. Any noise and/or dust issues are expected to be minimal. Permission to access private properties has been given by respective landowners.

Please note that some work at the smelter property may involve the use of digging equipment. ADEQ will use dust suppression during any such activity. In addition, ADEQ will repair any damage it may cause to the protective covering (called Posi-Shell) that has been placed on top of the dross waste at the smelter, to make sure it remains effective. The cover forms a hard crust that keeps the waste from entering the air on an interim basis until the final cleanup is performed.

FALL CLEAN UP DAYS (DUMP DAYS)

In order to prevent dumpster delivery mishaps, we have decided to change the dates of this years fall clean up. Dump days will be held for 5 days, instead of the historical 3, to allow more people to take advantage of the opportunity.

Starting on Monday, October 2nd, and continuing through Friday, October 6th, the Town will be accepting discarded items at the approved clean up locations.

There will be two locations, the Town lot at 12938 E. Main St. and the Maintenance Yard at S. Azurite and E. Third St.

At the Maintenance Yard location, we will be accepting the brush.

At the E. Main St. location, dumpsters will be available to handle your discards. Yard clippings, pine needles and horehound will only be accepted in trash bags. Items that will not be accepted are: tires; oils; hazardous chemicals; paint; refrigerators/freezers with freon/coolant canisters attached; household trash; and batteries.

Furniture (including mattresses), televisions and residential construction material (non-commercial), are all allowed.

BUILDING OFFICIAL'S CORNER

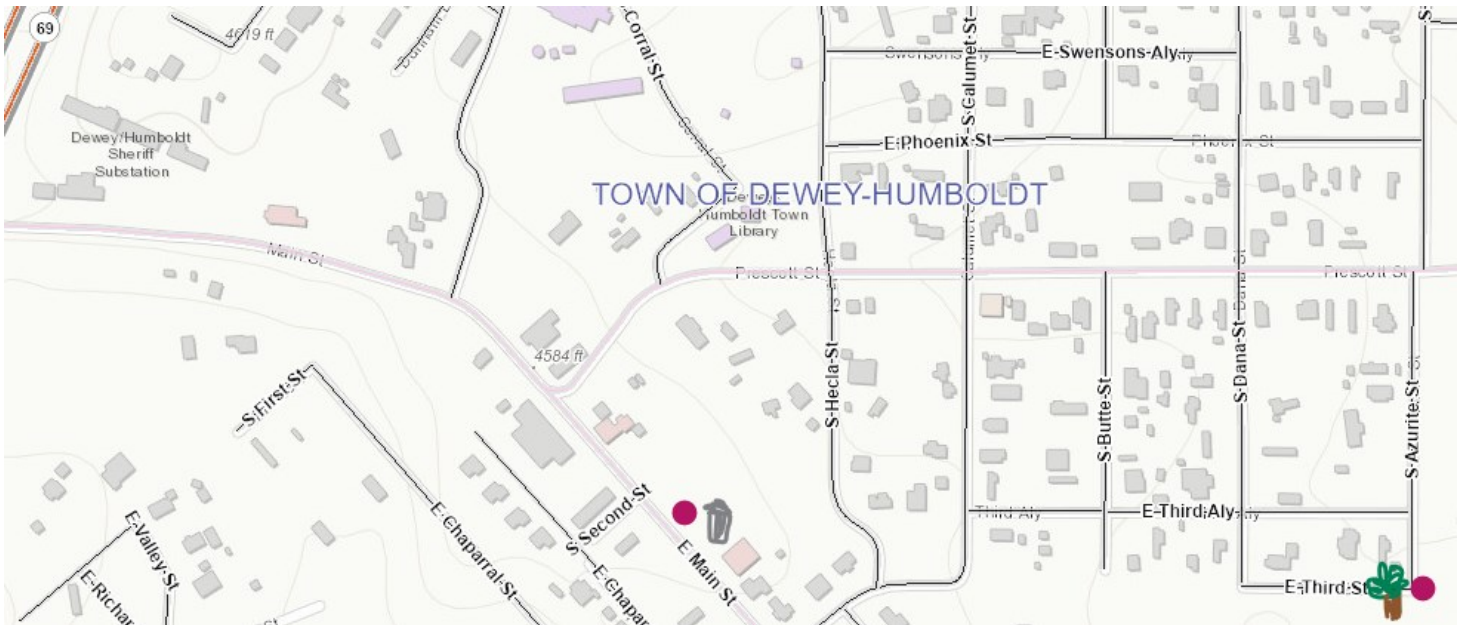

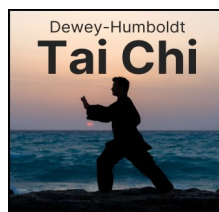
