NOTICE – HYDRANT METER POLICY CHANGES

August 25, 2023

Dear Customer,

A new bulk water sales policy is being proposed which would impact the way Prescott Valley's hydrant meters are used.

The new policy will allow hydrant meters to be used only for temporary construction purposes. Most other uses, whether existing or new, would not be allowed. To assist our existing customers in making this transition, there will be a three-year implementation period during which existing users could continue to use the hydrant meters. During this time the Town will be exploring the possibility of constructing a water fill station that would be made available to any user requiring bulk water. At the start of the three-year implementation period any hydrant meter that is not used during a 60-day period would be removed from service and the service account would be closed. Any new applications for hydrant meter service would be restricted only to temporary construction uses.

The Town is also in the middle of a water rate study which will include possible changes to the hydrant meter rates and fees.

The Town would like to receive comments on this proposed policy from our fire hydrant bulk water customers. The Utilities Department will also be hosting an in-person open house meeting for comment and discussion on September 6, 2023 from 5PM to 6PM at the Town Civic Center located at 7501 E. Skoog Blvd. in conference room 330 located on the 3rd floor.

Starting on **Monday, October 2nd**, and continuing through **Friday, October 6th**, the Town will be accepting discarded items at the approved clean up locations. See the map in last month's Newsletter or online at dhaz.gov for exact location.

There will be two locations, the **Town lot at 12938 E. Main St.** and the **Maintenance Yard at S. Azurite and E. Third St.**

At the **Maintenance Yard** location, we **will be** accepting the brush.

At the **E. Main St.** location, dumpsters will be available to handle your discards. Yard clippings, pine needles and horehound **will only** be accepted in trash bags. Items that **will not** be accepted are: tires; oils; hazardous chemicals; paint; refrigerators/freezers with freon/coolant canisters attached; household trash; and batteries. Furniture (including mattresses), televisions and residential construction material (non-commercial), are all allowed.

BUILDING OFFICIAL'S CORNER**What is a Property Setback?**

All properties have a setback. Some might be 10 feet, and some might be 50 feet. Generally, you cannot build anything in your setback. It is a buffer between you and the surrounding landowners. Setbacks are on all sides of your property and can be different on each side as well.

Erecting anything in these setbacks or using them for storage is prohibited in the Town Code. If you are getting ready to build or install something less than 50 feet from the property line, it is not a bad idea to check with the Town first about setback and permit requirements.

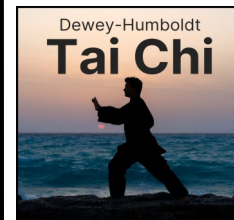
