BUILDING OFFICIAL'S CORNER

Solar has become very popular. As the building inspector, I see more and more systems getting installed in our town. When considering solar, I would like to leave you with a question: Why do you want solar?

Do you want it to lower your power bill costs, or do you want it to power your house when APS has a power outage? Typically, these two ideas require different designs and different costs. When you work with a solar company, they need to explain these two ideas to you so you can make the best decisions.

Permits – Solar requires a permit from the town to install and/or upgrade. APS will want a clearance from the town to install their meters. Most solar companies will take care of this for you by coordinating with the town on your behalf. Arizona Revised Statutes 32-1170.01 requires any installation, alteration, or repair of a solar device to be done by an Arizona Registrar of Contractors Licensee for solar.

SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

In the event we receive heavy snow in the coming months, the snow removal plan is as follows:

Staff will start with the main collector/feeder roads throughout Town, then work into the smaller neighborhood roads. We will get to all Town owned roads as quickly as possible. The snowplow blade is wide, and the truck has to move slowly in order to effectively remove the snow. When snow removal is in process, there may be traffic delays on Town owned roads. Your patience would be appreciated.

During a snowstorm, we also ask our residents to avoid parking vehicles on the roads. Vehicles parked on the roads may become an obstacle for the Town's truck to remove snow.



WINTERTIME SAFETY TIPS

Gas Fuel Appliances:

Change out air filters, check appliances for gas leaks and check out exhaust and combustible air ventilation systems. It is recommended to have a licensed mechanical contractor do a complete check-up on the gas heating system. A carbon monoxide detector is also a highly recommended device if you use gas-fuel appliances.

Smoke Alarms:

Replace the batteries and TEST the alarms to make sure they are in good working order.

Wood Stove/Fireplace/Pellet Stove:

Clean the flue/exhaust pipes regularly to ensure your appliances work more efficiently.

Doors & Windows:

Replace any worn out weather stripping around the doors and windows.

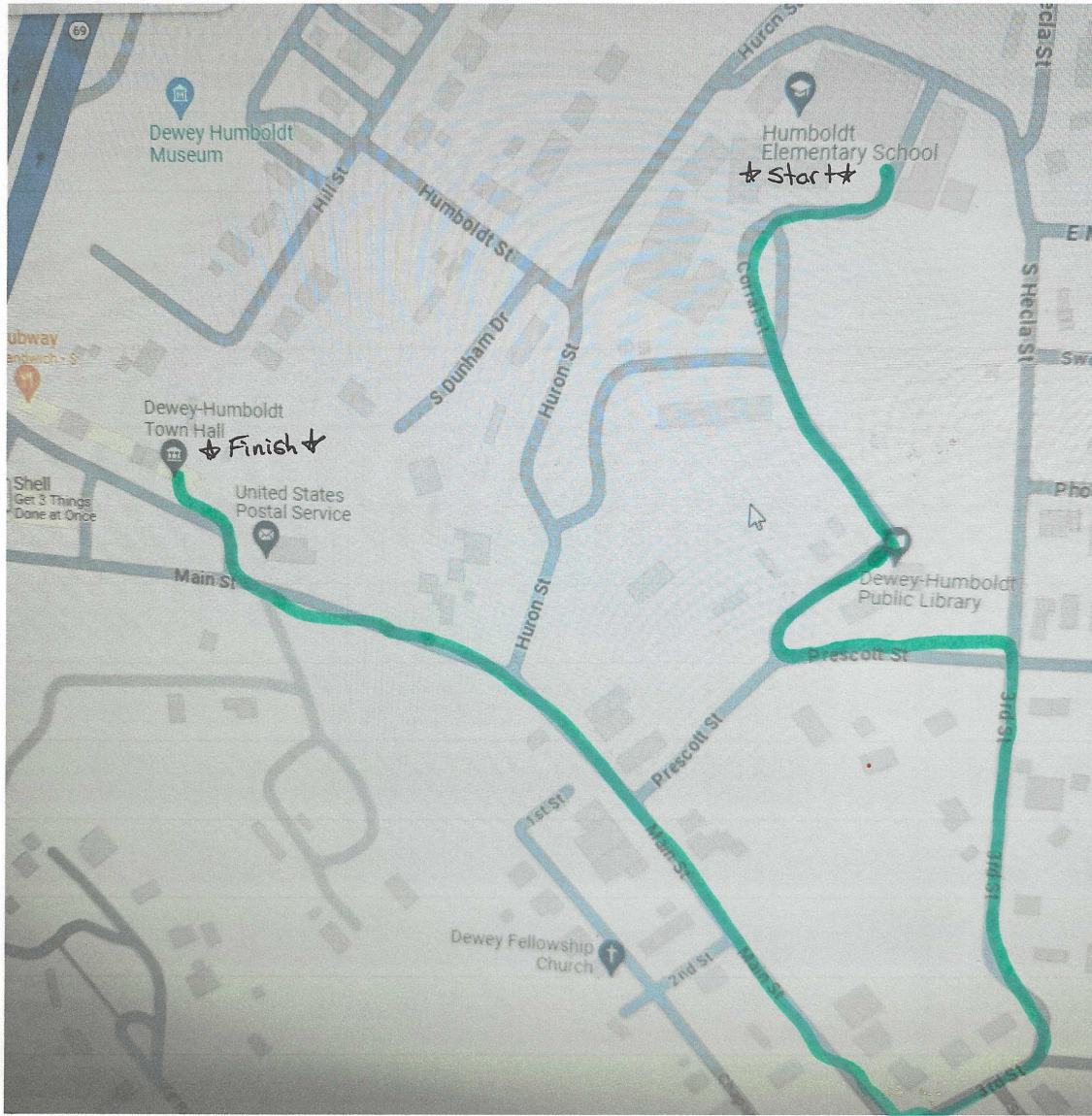

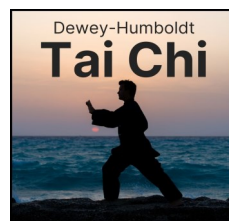
