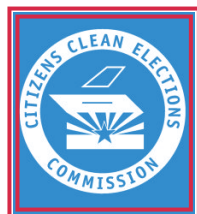
2024 PRIMARY ELECTION JULY 30, 2024

The Town's 2024 candidate elections will be for a Mayoral seat (2-year term) and four Town Council Member seats (three 4-year terms and one 2-year term).

Dates to keep in mind:

- July 1: Voter Registration Deadline**
- July 3: Early Voting Begins**
- July 19: Last day to request an early ballot**
- July 26: Last day to vote early in person**
- July 30: Primary Election Day**

It's Time Again to Prepare for Evacuation

Wildfires are starting throughout the western-US and the likelihood of one within our Town is somewhere between HIGH and VERY HIGH. The County has two applications that you need to have available. The first is **Everbridge**, [their new READY, SET, GO notification system that's a replacement to Code Red. You'll want you and your children's home, work, and cell phone numbers, and possibly email connected with Everbridge. Using any computer or internet capable cell phone, do an internet search for Yavapai County Everbridge or go straight to <https://member.everbridge.net/337829242601768/new>.](#)

Then create an account and provide contact information. If you only have a home phone, ask a friend for assistance to add your phone number. Once completed, all in-zone (see below) included contact information will automatically be notified when there's an emergency. They'll still use three potential steps:

READY: start getting prepared to evacuate

SET: get the family and animals together and be prepared to depart

GO: leave now for your evacuation destination. Note: the first notification can be a **GO**.

Genasys Protect is another new application which you can see at www.protect.genasys.com. One visit may be enough to determine the evacuation zones for your home, workplace, and children's school. Instead of vague areas and cross streets, notifications will use pre-determined, 8-character zones. At any time, you can go to the website and, based on any county address, determine a zone and check its status. If any potential emergency is nearby, it would be wise to have your pertinent zone(s) on hand so that you're not looking up the information when the adrenalin's pumping. You can also download the application to your internet capable cell phone to be alerted, but if you've already connected to **Everbridge**, it'll be redundant – not necessarily a bad thing.
