*The Older Americans Act (OAA) was signed into law on July 14, 1965 and is reauthorized periodically. The act established the Administration on Aging and created the Aging Services Network that includes the 56 State Units on Aging, 629 Area Agencies on Aging, 246 Title VI Native American aging programs and over 20,000 service provider organizations. In September 2006, Congress reauthorized the OAA reinforcing its mission to enhance the ability of older Americans to live with maximum dignity and independence while adding several new initiatives to the existing responsibilities of the aging services network. In 2017 the OAA was reauthorized by Congress.*


# *Christmas* ANGEL TREE
