NEWS FROM TOWN HALL

U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY- RESIDENTIAL SOIL SAMPLING UPDATE

The last round of soil sampling for 2024 was complete as of mid-December. At this point we have collected more than 6800 samples from 780 quarter-acre areas within 211 property parcels. We have sampled all properties we currently have permission from property owners. Residents who have not yet submitted a consent for access form can still turn one in. The next sampling event will occur in Summer, 2025.

Residents will begin to receive the first round of soil sampling results in January 2025. The results packages will continue to arrive on a rolling basis. Residents with properties EPA has identified for cleanup will be contacted individually regarding a cleanup plan for your yard.

EPA's Iron King Mine-Humboldt Smelter Superfund Site team hopes the community of Dewey Humboldt had a festive holiday season and wish you a Happy New Year! We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we work to protect human health and the environment in Dewey Humboldt.

Yavapai County K-to-12 Teachers (home and at school) - There's still time to get your students involved in the calendar contest for the **Dewey-Humboldt Firewise**

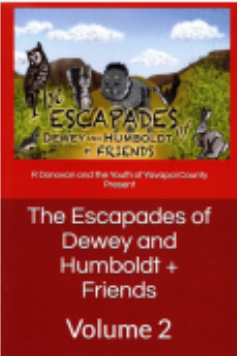
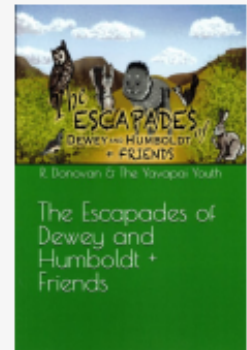
