WHAT IS OUR GENERAL PLAN?

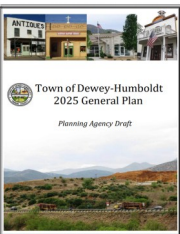
1. Management A General Plan helps the community manage land through directions on growth, zoning, and capacity. It guides future land use and development.

2. Requirements Arizona State Law requires all Arizona cities and towns to have a comprehensive long-range general plan for development. General Plans do NOT raise taxes or change approved zoning!

3. Statements A General plan states the community vision, goals, objectives, development policies, and strategies to achieve the goals and objectives.

4. Explanations The plan includes maps, diagrams, and text to set forth the objectives, principles, standards, and proposals for the community. The plan is effective for a period of 10 years from original date then must be reevaluated.

5. Elements The Dewey-Humboldt General Plan includes elements addressing land use, circulation, cost of development, open space, environmental planning, and water resources.

SHAPE THE FUTURE OF YAVAPAI COUNTY SERVICES

Stop by the Dewey-Humboldt Public Library on Thursday, **August 14th, between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM** for a community open house hosted by Yavapai County.

This informal, open-house style event is a chance to learn about findings from earlier community surveys and local partner input—and to share what you feel is most needed in your community today, from library services to public safety and beyond.

What to Expect:

- A brief overview of what we've learned so far
 - Interactive boards and posters to gather your input
 - County staff on hand to answer questions and listen to your ideas
 - Opportunities to leave written feedback
- Whether you have five minutes or 30, your voice matters. Your feedback will help shape future County planning efforts and ensure they reflect the priorities of Dewey-Humboldt residents.

Can't make it? Informational displays and comment materials will remain at the library after the event so you can still contribute your thoughts.

FREE BRUSH PICK-UP FROM YOUR PROPERTY

Dead fuel as in brush and general cut and dead vegetation, is super fuel for fire ignition. If you have any piles around your property, you should consider those are fire hazards. Do you have a pile of brush you want to get rid of? Here's your chance.

Dewey-Humboldt Firewise is sponsoring **2 FREE pick-up days**, from individual properties, for **BRUSH/Vegetation only**. All you need to know is:

1. **BRUSH** you want hauled must be heaped by you into **ONE neat pile** and be situated near or alongside a private driveway or open area on your property, so that a dump truck and small tractor can access easily (**and gates open, no loose dogs**)
2. **Do NOT** dump any piles on any public road.
3. **Only ONE** pile per household is allowed **FREE. BRUSH only, NO trash or other waste debris, NO CACTUS.**
4. **If you want more work done than ONE PILE of BRUSH you must negotiate separately with the contractor outside of and not connected to the Firewise offer.**
5. **Dewey-Humboldt Firewise covers costs of all fees and labor for one-time pick-up.**
6. We are contracting services of **GREEN ACRES by Jose**. Jose is one of the Firewise contractors and will do a lovely job for you, providing all the labor to collect the brush pile.
7. **We reserve the right to NOT pick up any pile that contains anything other than brush, is not easily accessible, or is too big for a truckload.**

2 DAYS ONLY for this FREE pick-up: BLUE HILLS side, **West side of 69**, properties **AUGUST 28 th , 2025 (Thursday)** . Town to Foothill Drive, **East side of 69**, properties **AUGUST 29 th , 2025 (Friday)**.

First come, first served! If you want a pick-up please **EMAIL** asap to: VivienWinneke.Firewise@gmail.com with specific info: 1. Your name & full address, 2. Telephone #, 3. Describe dump truck access to the **PILE ON YOUR PROPERTY** (driveway, flat open area to left of house etc.).

If you make it to our list for one of the 2 days, we will call you to confirm.

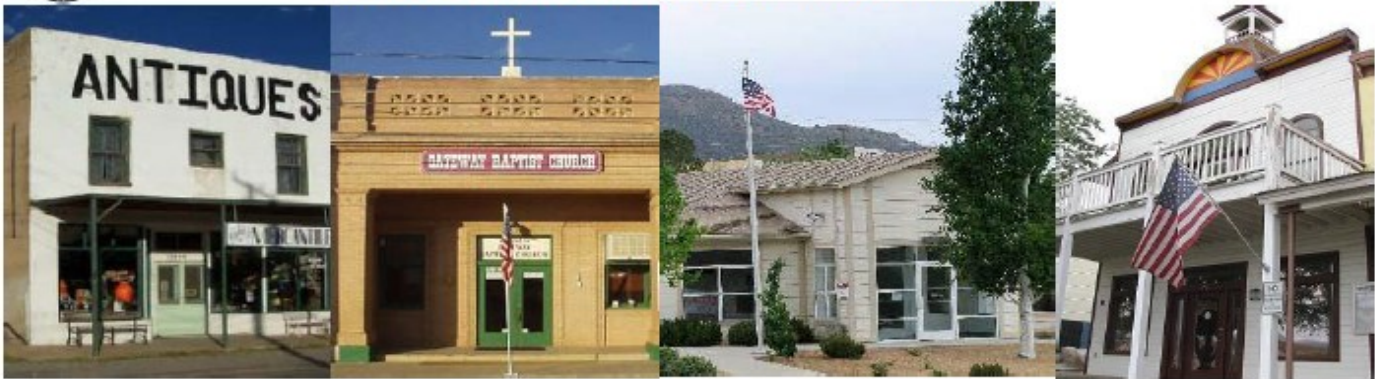

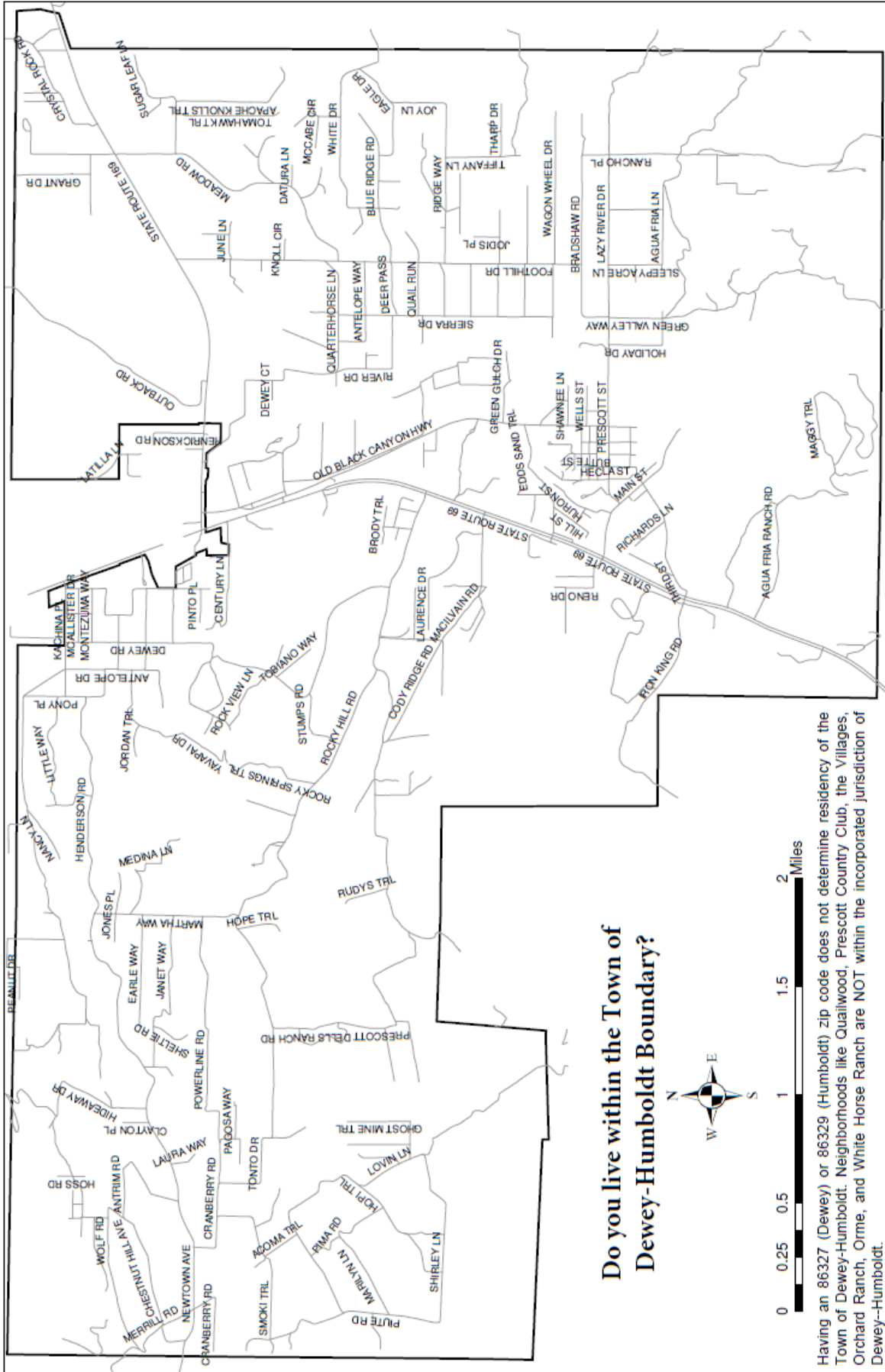

PINTO BEAN SPICE CAKE

From Beans 'n Things by Winkie Crigler

- 1/2 c softened butter
- 1 c sugar
- 2 eggs slightly beaten
- 1 c warm water
- 1 tsp soda
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 c mashed pinto beans
- 1 c sweetened apple sauce
- 1 tp allspice
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 c raisins
- 1 c chopped nuts



Cream butter and sugar. Add slightly beaten eggs, water and dry ingredients alternately. Stir in beans, raisins, nuts, applesauce and vanilla. Bake in greased pans at 350 degrees 40 to 50 minutes. Makes two moist loaves or flat cake. When cooled, frost with cream cheese or caramel frosting.

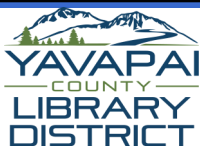
