FUELWOOD AND CHRISTMAS TREE PERMITS

The Prescott National Forest provides firewood for personal use. A permit is required by anyone harvesting any firewood on the National Forest, except for the rather small amounts used in a campfire and gathered at the campfire site.



This permit allows you to cut Christmas Trees within designated areas of the Prescott National Forest. For the 2025 season, the permits encompass most the Bradshaw and Chino Ranger Districts and the Western portion of the Verde Ranger District on Mingus Mountain. Maps displaying areas open to cutting are available for download below. Please be sure to read and agree to all the tips and guidelines when selecting your tree.



Christmas tree permits are to be used for personal uses, only one permit per house hold. No modifications, cancellations, or refunds can take place once you complete your purchase.

Dewey-Humboldt Historical Society Members and the General Public are invited to hear local author Bradley Courtney share a story of a jealous husband, dynamite and attempted murder back in the rough and tumble days of Whiskey Row.

Join us on **Wednesday, November 12th at 5:30 PM** at the Agua Fria Church on 2nd Street in Historic Humboldt.

Bradley G. Courtney is a historian with five books about Prescott's Whiskey Row to his credit. He lived and taught in Phoenix, Arizona, for nineteen years.

Prior to this, he lived and taught on the Navajo Indian Reservation in northern Arizona for twelve years. For six of those years, he was also a riverboat pilot and guide who gave tours down the incomparable canyons of the Colorado River—Glen Canyon, Marble Canyon, and the Grand Canyon.

Bradley holds a bachelor's degree in religion from Excelsior College and a master's degree in history from California State University.

His current book project is Doc Holliday and Kate at the Crossroads.

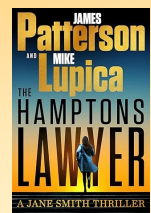
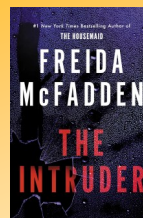
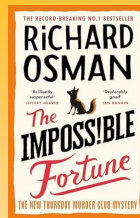
